- (B) Financial: Synchronized Competitions split profit with Tri States Council 50 / 50, and the Freeskating Competitions split profit with Tri States Council 60 / 40.
- (C) Areas included in Financials: Registration Monies, Ticket Sales (Synchronized), less Official's and Ice Expenses, medals, rentals, mailing expenses, etc.
